Come in ahead of class and have Dr. Ron get it working well so you can concentrate on learning and enjoying this class.) If you would prefer, you may use one of our classroom machines -- just let us know ahead of class.

* Bring the foot control & cord for your machine

- * Normal Sewing Foot for 1/2 seams
- __ * Walking Foot
 - * Needles 90/14 Universal

- * Glass head silk pins (or other good quality sewing pins)

- __ * You may cut your fabric before class if you want to



FABRIC:

For a 64" X 64" lap quilt made with 8 1/2" squares you will need 64 squares for the top and 64 squares for the back. You will need 4 yards of fabric or 64 squares of assorted fabrics for each side.

For a 52" X 52" lap quilt made with 6 1/2" squares you will need 64 squares for the top and 64 squares for the back. You will need 2 1/3 yards fabric or 64 squares of assorted fabrics for each side.

For example: If you are making the 64" X 64" lap quilt you can use 64 assorted squares for the front of your quilt and use 4 yards of the same fabric for the back of the quilt.

Fabrics that work well are flannels, homespun, and denim. You want fabrics that will fray. If you are going to use denim, you will not need to use batting.

If you are going to use flannel or homespun you can use fabric for your batting.

* These items are available at Paramount. You will receive a 15% class discount. Please purchase these items well in advance of your class to make sure you have them. We stock these items, but you don't want to wait until the last minute.
